SILENT AUCTION

All items listed as silent auction are displayed on tables and have a bid sheet beside them. To bid, place your bid number in the space provided. Many items have starting/minimum bids. Each change of the bid must exceed the current bid by at least \$2.00. You may bid on an item as many times as you wish.

Tables will close at various times throughout the evening. Winning bids will be decided by the last written bid on the sheet. If you have the winning bid, please leave the Bid Sheet on the table and remove the winning item after the winning bid has been recorded.
